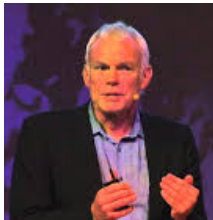

## “When Trust Goes Tipi Haere”

We are excited to have Chris Skellett, former Clinical Psychologist, Fellow and active Life Member of the NZCCP and Internationally acclaimed Author of *“When Trust Goes Missing (2019).”* This wānanga will explore “trust issues” and why as Practitioners, we need to have a greater understanding why “trust was broken” and the recovery processes of trust reconciliation. Chris re-defines Trust as an “assumption of positive and affirming outcomes.” He says, “It is not something we have, it is something we do.”

We are also excited that local Hapū whānau Doctoral student Ngarongo Ormsby will share some of his research into historical intergenerational trauma and Pōraruraru - Māori Conflict. Why *“Trust goes Tipi Haere”* is a greater issue for Māori as an unconscious bias receiving health intervention services. Ngarongo says when subjugation policies were applied to Māori, this propositioned Māori into a deficit position by the Crown into a servitude situation, contrary to the Treaty of Waitangi 1840 and more recently the UN Declarations on the Rights of Indigenous Peoples 2007.

# Marae Protocols

---

<b>Marae:</b>	Wairoa Marae, SH2, Bethlehem, Tauranga, 1km north of the Bethlehem Shops on the right handside
<b>Hapū:</b>	Ngāti Kahu
<b>Iwi:</b>	Ngāti Ranginui
<b>Waka:</b>	Takitumu
<b>Date:</b>	29 February 2020
<b>Time:</b>	9.00am Assemble at the Marae entrance gate (arrive at 8.45am)
<b>Purpose:</b>	<b>Wānanga o te Rā, “When Trusts goes Tipi Haere”</b>
<b>Estimated end:</b>	4.00pm

## Protocol/Kawa:

You will assemble in the car park. A koha collection may occur, give to your Kaikōrero speaker. This will be placed down for the haukainga at the conclusion of the speeches. A karanga will indicate for you proceed onto the marae, the women shall go first with the men in behind. You will stop and pause to remember those who have passed on, then continue to proceed to the wharenui. Remove your shoes and enter the wharenui. The women will proceed to the seats behind the paetapu, that is where the kaikōrero male speakers will sit. When your speakers sit, it is a signal for everyone to then sit. The haukainga will stand and speak first, give a waiata, then sit. Your side (Manuhiri) Kaikōrero speaker will stand and reply to the haukainga. When he has completed his speech, you will all need to have a waiata to support him, he will then at the completion of the waiata, lay down the koha and sit down. The haukainga will speak next, a waiata and then they will motion for the manuhiri (all of you) to proceed forward to hongis and greet them. The men will go first to hongis followed by the women. At the completion of this protocol/kawa you were in a state of tapu, you are now essentially in a state of noa and the marae complex then becomes your home for the day. Everyone will proceed to the wharekai for a cuppa tea and to eat to whakanoa the rituals of encounter. Following this, everyone will reassemble in the Wharenui to commence the proceeding for the day. We have suggested a waiata to support your Kaikōrero speaker. To learn it, go to the Youtube address and practice. Don't be surprised if the Kaikōrero sings a different song, there are reasons why this may occur.
